Expedition Training and Assessor Accreditation

The DofE have issued a date by which anyone wishing to assess expeditions must be fully accredited through the new scheme. This date is: 1st April 2010.

The Scout Association has received an extension to this date, which means that you have to attend the course and completed your supported assessment by 1st April 2011.

Training Courses

The Scouting Organisation are now running a variety of DofE training courses across the UK. This training is focussing on the delivery of:

- Intro to the DofE, a one day course for leaders new to working with the DofE; and
- EAAS, the basic one day training required for those wishing to become assessors for the Expedition Section.

Introduction to the DofE

This course is running across England in different geographical areas. Please see below for dates and locations in the Midlands area:

- November 14th, venue TBC (Staffordshire)
- January 16th, venue TBC (Warwickshire)

There will be a cost of £15 per person; which will cover the cost of course materials, refreshments and lunch. Applications for courses will close 1 week before the course.

EAAS – routes to accreditation

To become an accredited Expedition Assessor you need to complete the relevant e-learning training elements and attend a training course, as well as completing a supported assessment.

The aim of EAAS is to prepare, train and accredit assessors to undertake expedition assessments. Please see below for dates and locations in the Midlands:

- November 15th, venue TBC (Staffordshire)
- January 16th, venue TBC (Warwickshire)

There will be a cost of £15 per person; which will cover the cost of course materials, refreshments and lunch.
